Intergroup Representatives MEETING
MINUTES
Tuesday, November 5th, 2019**

CALL TO ORDER: at 7:30 P.m. by Ed O. (Chairperson of the Steering Committee)

ROLL CALL: Ed O.(chair)*, Chuck T. (office manager) * Kate W. (Sobriety 1st) Bill S. (So. Yarmouth Action Group), Jesse M. (Hyannis Noontime) Bobby M (Pause at 5) Steve (Sandwich Sunday Morning) Paulette (Orleans 7 up) Jay G. (West Falmouth OBBSS)

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Jesse M. motioned to accept the secretaries report as written, motion seconded and passed unanimously

TREASURER'S REPORT: Bill S. asked about contributions Chuck T. stated donations are still ahead of last year. Motion made to accept the treasurer's report, motion seconded, motion carried.

DISTRICT 1&2 REPORT: No district rep present but Bill S. was at the meeting and spoke on it. He stated that the GSR from Hour of Power stated that change was needed at the Intergroup office. He stated that there have been many complaints and that the office manager is rude, doesn't say hello and has lost the entire lower Cape due to his inability to get out and attend these groups business meetings etc.

OFFICE MANAGER'S REPORT: 46 walk-ins, 68 phone calls. Chuck T spoke about update on moving towards the acceptance of credit cards in the office. Jesse M asked about expenditures for the month Chuck T. said he would provide at next month's meeting.

OLD BUSINESS: Bill S asked about the Steering Committee minutes. Ed O. Stated, "what is spoken about with Chuck is confidential" Bill S. objected. Chuck T. Stated, "nothing that we discuss is confidential" and told Bill S. what was discussed at the last Steering Committee meeting, including the unanimous vote to go back to regular hours starting January 6th. Bill S. spoke on the history of Intergroup and how 20 years ago volunteers worked and how the office can't afford a full-time office manager and that it's time for a change. Jesse M. spoke on the importance of having a local intergroup. Kate W. believes in having an office manager and that we need active volunteers to staff the office when Chuck is on vacation etc. Paulette spoke in support of Kate and also the importance of Intergroup in the community. Bill S. responded stating that the office hours need to be increased, that there have been "tons" of complaints about the office manager, discouraging volunteers and not outreaching to the groups. Bill S. implored the reps not to put the office manager back to full time. Bill S. made a motion to tell the Steering Committee to put on hold the reassigning Chuck T. back to full time status until further discussion and a vote by the reps. Motion seconded by Jesse M. discussion ended with members stating they needed time to process and bring back to their groups. Bill S. amended his motion to vote on the issue of a full VS part-time office manager, the use of volunteers to staff the office and the office manager hours in 90 days (Feb. IGR meeting) motion passed.
