This is painful to write but Intergroup is in financial trouble and needs the support of the Cape Cod A.A. community. As I am sure everyone else is aware, the costs of everything continue to increase. Rent, books and supplies etc. it seems that everything these days is more expensive. Simple math has shown us that after months of more money going out than is coming in has put us in the position of me chosing a paycheck or buying books and medallions. I chose the books and didn't get paid for 2 weeks. We have made the needed cuts here at Intergroup and Now we are forced to charge for the shipping of items. We can no longer afford the loss associated with paying the cost of shipping. Our margins are so thin that just the added cost of shipping negates any modest income made from the sale. Intergroup is in real danger of eventually closing within a year if things don't turn around. Please support your Intergoup. We are fortunate to have this place and it would be terrible to lose it.
